

Yap Catholic High School
Application Process for Academic Year 2019-2020
Off Island Applicants

You must submit the following by **Wednesday, March 6th**:

- 1) Completed "Application Form"
- 2) Copies of Official Transcript(s) or Report Cards that cover(s) at least 6th, 7th grade (full year) and 8th grade (first semester)
- 3) "Recommendation Form" filled out by a 6th, 7th, or 8th grade teacher
- 4) \$5.00 application fee

Upon review of your application materials, the admissions committee will offer you conditional acceptance to attend our Summer Session. All conditionally admitted students will be required to successfully complete the Summer Session (which will take place from July 3 – July 30) in order to fully enroll as members of the class of 2023.

Cost for the Summer Session and registration is \$70. Tuition for the year is \$700. We do have financial aid available for families who demonstrate economic need. All families are asked to make some contribution towards tuition even if they are on a financial aid sponsorship.

Students must provide their own transportation to and from school each day. The public transportation company sends a bus to and from school each day. During the Summer Session, students must pay for this service. During the regular school year, DOE and PTS provide bus passes for students.

Students must coordinate their own living arrangements while on Yap Proper. Whoever the student stays with will act as the student's guardian during their time on Yap Proper.

Students may not miss any portion of the school year because of family trips off island, including to the Outer Islands. School is in session from July 3 – July 30, and then runs from the end of August until the end of May.

All students are expected to follow the school dress code which includes blue polo shirts which must be purchased from the school during the summer session. Polo shirts are \$13 each or 2 for \$25. Students may wear any black, dark blue, or gray shorts, pants, or skirts as part of their uniform. For the Summer Session, students will receive YCHS t-shirts (cost included in registration fee) to wear as their uniform.

For Outer Island students, please communicate any information through the St. Mary's Vicariate Office. Communication is key to a successful experience at Yap Catholic High School.

Application materials for Off Island Applicants are due on **Wednesday, March 6th**.
