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MISSION STATEMENT

Grounded in the Catholic faith, Yap Catholic High School strives to educate students to achieve academic excellence, appreciate their culture, be good stewards of the environment, and live their faith in the service of God and others.

SCHOOL

Founded in 2011, Yap Catholic High School is a co-educational, private, Catholic college preparatory high school (grades 9-12) located on a newly-developed, twenty-two acre rural campus in Yap, one of the island states of the Federated States of Micronesia, a nation that holds political and economic ties to the United States through their Compact of Free Association and as a former Trust Territory administered by the U.S. after World War II.

FACULTY & ACCREDITATION

Our ten-member faculty is comprised of priests from the Society of Jesus (Jesuits), volunteer teachers from the United States, and local residents totaling over 40 years of teaching experience. 40% of our teachers have at least one master's degree. All of our faculty members are certified teachers through the FSM Department of Education. Our student-to-faculty ratio is 9:1. YCHS holds a Level 4 Accreditation, the highest possible accreditation status from the FSM Department of Education.

ADMISSION

Our highly selective admission requires a two-step academic process. An applicant is invited to enter the incoming freshman class after successfully completing a month-long afterschool academic program during the spring semester and a four-week summer session focused on math, English language arts, and reading. Tuition is \$70 per month, and 56% of students receive financial aid or academic scholarships.

SCHEDULE

Yap Catholic High School operates on the semester system. The school day begins at 8:15 and ends at 4:00, including a mandatory study hall/activity period. All classes meet for 45 minutes each day. All students take six academic courses in addition to a daily elective/ silent reading period. Students must participate in an intensive Math and English 4-week program each summer for graduation.
